Clothing

Gently used men, women, and children's clothing, freshly cleaned and in good repair (no tears or stains)

- Sweaters, vests, jackets
- New underwear and socks
- Shoes, boots, and flip flops
- Winter hats, scarves, and gloves
- Summer hats
- Anne Arundel County school uniforms

Due to limited space, we are unable to accept

- Business or formal attire
- Swimsuits
- Belts and other clothing accessories

Household Items

Gently used items in good repair (working, no tears, stains, or missing parts) that have been freshly cleaned

- Linens
- Bedding
- Bathroom accessories (mats, curtains, etc.)
- Small kitchen appliances (toaster oven, mixers, coffee makers)
- Kitchen utensils
- Dishes - full sets
- Silverware in full sets
